Put the events in chronological order

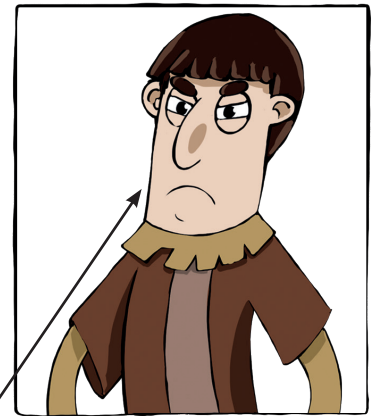
- 3 The Montagues and the Capulets start singing about fighting.

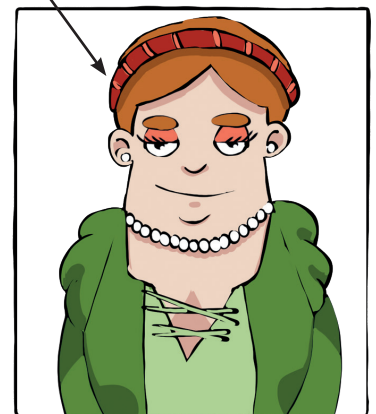
